

Your final grade for this course will be obtained from (1) Midterm exam (37.5%); (2) Final Exam (37.5%); and (3) Class Participation (25%). The 25% for class participation consists of 5% lecture attendance (S1) + 10% paper discussions (S2) + 10% class presentation (S3).

Lecture attendance (5%)

You are expected to attend regular and guest lectures. Your attendance score will be computed as follows:

$S1 = 5\% * A / (T - 1)$, where S1=score (ranging from 0-5%), A= number of lectures you attended, and T= total number of lectures. The (T-1) in the formula means that one lecture can be missed for any reason without any loss of credit. Beyond that, if you don't want to lose credit you should email me as soon as you can with a valid reason (such as sickness). If you do that I will send you a link to an audio recording of the lecture if one is available.

Paper discussions (10%)

You are expected to attend classes devoted to discussion of selected papers. A total of 7 papers will be discussed. You get credit for coming to class having read the paper and being prepared to ask and/or answer questions about it. Your score for paper discussion is computed from this formula: $S2 = 10\% * D / 7$, where S2 = score (ranging from 0-10%), and D=number of papers discussed. If you are absent for a paper discussion and want to make it up, you must email me within 48 hours after the missed class with a valid reason for your absence. To make it up, I will send you questions about the article which you should answer (using your own words, not by copying and pasting text from the article) and then email back to me within one week of the missed class. To encourage in-class participation, make-ups will provide full credit only for one absence, and half credit after that (unless there are exceptional circumstances*).

Class presentation (10%)

This is an approximately 10 minute conference-style oral presentation of a research (not review) paper using powerpoint (or equivalent) that will be presented near the end of the semester. The score (S3) for this will be determined from inclusion of required elements (Intro, Methods, Results, Discussion, 2 pts), adherence to time constraints (2 pts) and quality/clarity of presentation (6 pts). Further instructions regarding the format of the presentation and other details will be given in class.
